

For the month of June I would suggest revising the following areas: Nursery rhymes (see list of ones covered this year below), Gross motor work you have been doing over the last few weeks, Jigsaw, Fine motor and sorting/matching work, stories covered (see list below) and any songs covered over the last few weeks.

I will include new ideas for outside play, sensory play and art each week but the main focus, as always, is on fun, hands on activities and getting out in the sunshine as much as possible! If you can, continue with the work on life skills and developing independence also.

June 1st – 5th

Outside play: A sensory walk in the garden: Use as many sensory bins/trays/containers as you like and fill them with whatever you have at home e.g. water beads, sand, dry black beans, chickpeas, shaving foam, coloured water etc. Encourage them to walk through the different trays in their bare feet!

Sensory play: Add some magnetic letters into a big tub/box of rice/sand/lentils/cous cous. Write the same letters on a baking tray and encourage the boys to find the letters in the tub and match them to the correct ones on the baking tray.

Art: Create a paper plate/hand printed sun.



You could play Mr. Sun, Sun Mr. Golden sun/Kids songs/Supersimple songs on Youtube as they do their art 😊
